Mission Statement: FMAYS provides a rigorous orchestral experience which challenges dedicated youth to reach their full potential musically and personally and emerge as dynamic members of the community.

FMAYS is a 501(c)3 organization, and donations are tax deductible.

About Us

The Fargo Moorhead Area Youth Symphonies was founded in 1967 to give musically talented students an opportunity to expand their musical experiences. FMAYS was designed as an addition to middle and high school music education programs in the community.

FMAYS consists of three orchestras: Concert Strings (grades 6-8), Attacca Strings (grades 9-12), and the Symphony Orchestra (grades 9-12). Encore Chamber is an additional opportunity for Symphony Orchestra members to participate in chamber music. Each year, an FMAYS' Founders Concerto Competition is held.

The orchestras rehearse weekly from September to April and put on 6 concerts throughout the school year. Every year, the Symphony Orchestra participates in a special side-by-side rehearsal and performance with the Fargo Moorhead Symphony Orchestra.

Auditions are required before each year of participation for all orchestras.

Opportunities for FMAYS Students

- Participate in 3-6 concerts each season
- Make music with students from schools within a 100-mile radius of the FM Area
- Perform in a variety of venues such as Festival Concert Hall at NDSU, VCSU Center for the Arts, Memorial Auditorium at Concordia, TAK Event Center, and First Presbyterian Church
- Learn from local professional musicians in sectionals
- Perform with local guest artists
- Participate in a special side-by-side rehearsal and performance with the Fargo Moorhead Symphony Orchestra
- Perform in Encore Chamber (small Chamber groups with 3-10 people)
- Travel to Valley City for an outreach concert
- Compete in the FMAYS' Founders Concerto Competition, with the winner performing their concerto with the Symphony Orchestra
- Free admission to Fargo Moorhead Symphony Orchestra Masterworks concerts

Erling Linde Scholarship
